# Guildford and South Surrey Parkinson's Branch

## NEW 100 Club Rules

New 100 Club start date is 1<sup>st</sup> July 2026, with draws held monthly thereafter.

### Purpose

The purpose of the NEW 100 Club (the Club) is to raise funds for the Guildford and South Surrey Parkinson's Branch (the Branch). Monthly subscription payments for the Club member's numbers purchased will be paid into the Branch bank account and used to fund both the Club prize monies and the various social and other activities the Branch provides.

### Rules

1. The Club is a private lottery and is open to all Branch members, their carer's, family and friends provided they have become a member of the Club. Anyone aged 16 or over can join.
2. For a cost of £5 per month (*per draw*) Club members will be allocated one number for the draw. The number may be higher than 100 if the Club already has in-excess of 100 numbers subscribed each month.
3. Club members may subscribe for more than one number.
4. Numbers will be allocated at random to Club members. Club members requests for personal numbers will be accommodated where possible, but there is no guarantee, and the Club Coordinator's decision is final.
5. Once allocated the Club member will have the same numbers each month.
6. Club member's numbers will only be entered if their monthly payment subscription is up to date.
7. Club member payments must be made annually in advance by Standing Order, Bank Transfer, or Cheque. An Annual Standing Order payment is preferable, to ensure the subscription payment is not forgotten by the Club member.
8. Three-month's notice in writing to the Club Coordinator is required for cancellation of membership. During this three-month notice period, the members numbers will still be entered into the monthly draws.
9. Any remaining prepaid payments after the three-months will be refunded
10. A draw of all eligible (*paid for*) numbers will be made every month with a 1st, 2nd and 3rd prize.
11. Monthly prizes total £175, apportioned as: 1st prize = £100, 2nd prize = £50 and 3rd prize = £25. These prize amounts may be increased in the future if there is sufficient membership of the Club to allow this and there is sufficient income for the Branch.
12. The Club monthly draw will be on the last Tuesday afternoon of each month where possible.
13. The winning Club members will be paid their prize by bank transfer to their personal bank account or by cheque posted to the address on their membership application within one week of the draw.
14. The name and numbers for each month's winners will be published in the Branch PARK magazine.
15. The Club will be run by the Branch Committee. In case of any dispute the decision of the Committee is final.
16. A Club member will be deemed to have left the 100 Club if their subscription renewal remains unpaid for a period of three-months.
17. If a winner cannot be contacted/their prize cheque remains uncashed after six months from issue, the winning amount will be cancelled and the amount will be placed into Branch general funds.
